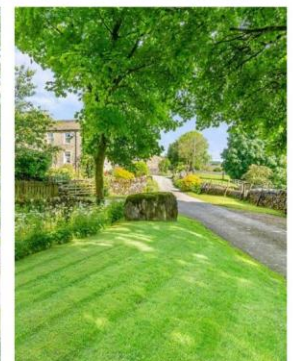

BUSES RUN THROUGH THRESHFIELD TO SKIPTON, GRASSINGTON AND UPPER WHARFEDALE AS FOLLOWS:

- Keighley Bus Company service 72 runs between Skipton and Grassington seven days a week.
- Upper Wharfedale Venturer minibus service 72B: links to the 72 bus and runs between Hebden, Grassington and Buckden, Monday to Saturday

RAILWAYS SERVICES

Skipton Railway Station, Broughton Road, Skipton, BD23 1RT. Approximately 9 miles from Threshfield, and reachable by the 72 bus from Threshfield. The station provides links to national rail services.

A taxi from Grassington to Skipton costs around £25 each way. Taxis to Leeds are about £80.

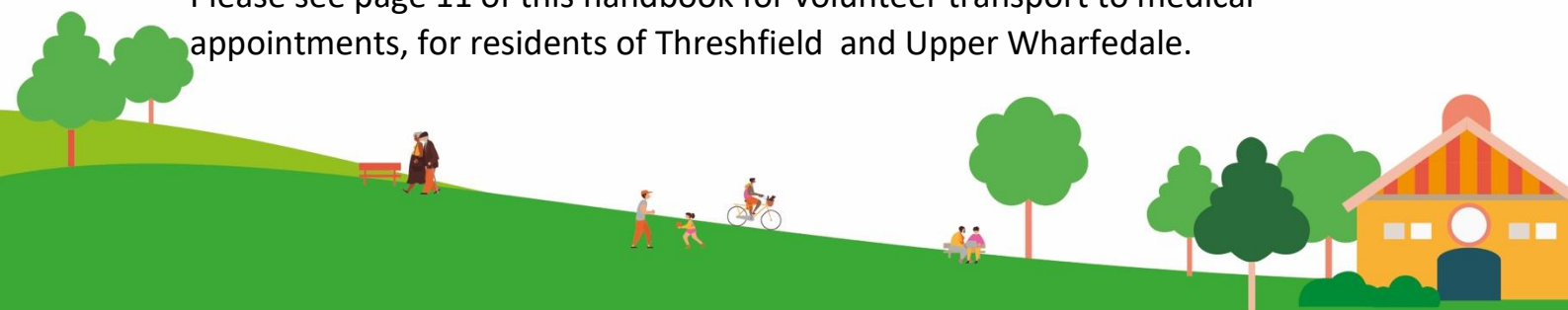
