The guide contains up-to-date and relevant information about the area.

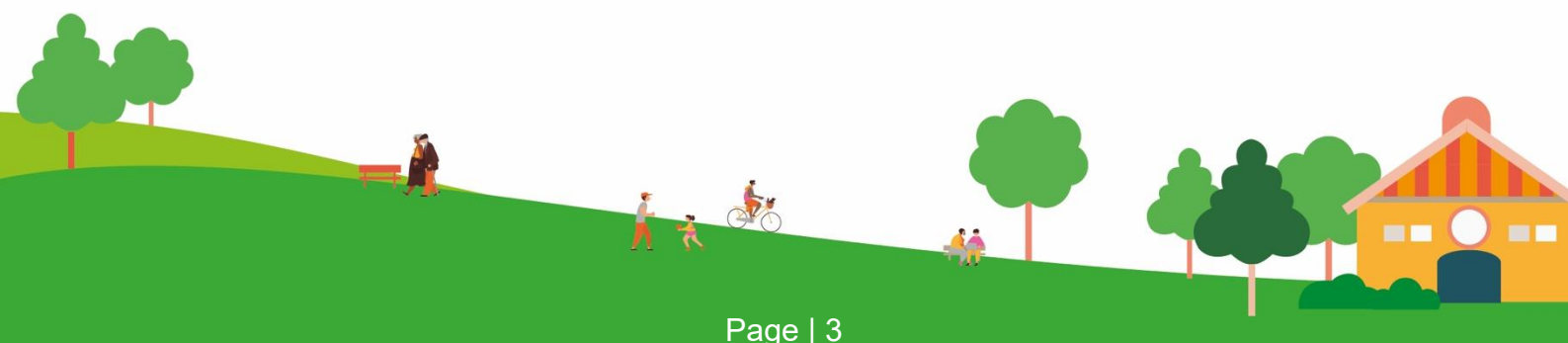

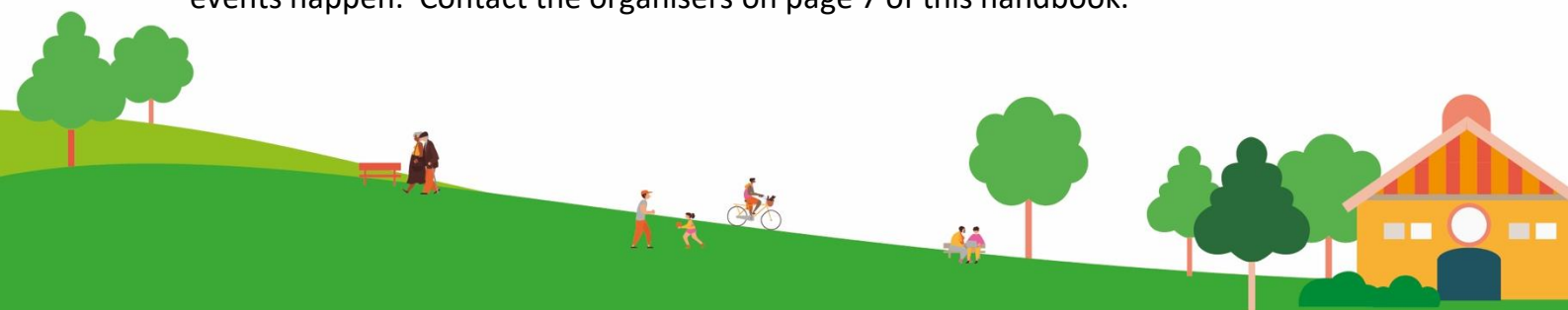

BUSES RUN BETWEEN SKIPTON, GRASSINGTON AND UPPER WHARFEDALE AS FOLLOWS:

- Keighley Bus Company service 72 runs between Skipton and Grassington seven days a week.
- Upper Wharfedale Venturer minibus service 72B: links to the 72 bus and runs between Hebden, Grassington and Buckden, Monday to Saturday

RAILWAYS SERVICES

Gargrave Railway Station, Church Street, Gargrave BD23 3NE. Approximately 9 miles from Grassington. The station provides links from Morecambe to Leeds, via Skipton.

Skipton Railway Station, Broughton Road, Skipton, BD23 1RT. Approximately 10 miles from Grassington, and reachable by the 72 bus from Grassington, the station provides links to national rail services at Leeds station.
